

DIRECTIONS TO GWYNN VALLEY CAMP

301 Gwynn Valley Trail

FROM I-26 East or West:

Exit at the Asheville Airport Road, Exit #40, Hwy 280. Follow signs to Brevard (Hwy 280). Continue straight for 19.5 miles. (Highway 280 will turn into 64/276 on the outskirts of Brevard.) In the center of Brevard (at the courthouse) turn left onto Main St./276 South. Follow 276 for 4.4 miles to Island Ford Road (at Mud Dabbers Pottery). Turn right; travel 1.4 miles to Gwynn Valley on the left.

FROM I-85 SOUTH (ATLANTA):

Take I-85 North to first exit in SC: Cherokee Scenic Highway (SC Hwy 11). Remain on Hwy 11 (approximately 55 miles) until you turn **LEFT** on SC #8; then left on Hwy 276. At NC state line you are 8.8 miles from Island Ford Road. Turn left onto Island Ford Road and travel 1.4 miles to Gwynn Valley on the left.

Hwy 276 is a winding mountain road so the going is slow.

FROM I-85 NORTH (CHARLOTTE):

Take I-85 South. At Gastonia, exit onto Hwy 74. Remain on Hwy 74 until you reach I-26 West. Follow the I-26 directions above.

The following are approximate driving times to Gwynn Valley:

Asheville, NC – 1 hour

Charlotte, NC – 2 ½ hours

Raleigh, NC – 5 hours

Atlanta, Ga. – 3 ½ hours

Knoxville, Tn. – 2 hours

Nashville, Tn. – 5 hours

Columbia, SC – 3 hours

Greenville, SC – 1 hour

Charlottesville, Va. – 6 hours

Roanoke, Va – 4 ½ hours

Richmond, Va. – 7 hours
